## EVENTS

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- **NATO's Open Door Policy:** On 23 November 2023, in cooperation with NATO, TPQ organized a panel discussion on "NATO's Open Door Policy". During the panel, participants discussed the alliance's previous enlargement processes, highlighting the phases the alliance went through after the collapse of the Soviet Union, as well as the threats and opportunities facing the alliance's enlargement processes today. The event reviewed how the members of the alliance, particularly the U.S., the alliance's leading member, view the enlargement policy and the possible consequences of this policy.
- **Summer Research:** Enemy or rival: The coverage of the opposition in pro-government media language
- Project description: This project utilizes machine learning tools to categorize the entire news corpus of several Turkish newspapers for an extended period in terms of the language they use to cover the main opposition party. (The categorization will provide the data for a study of media behavior in a context of polarization and institutional change). To train the machine algorithm, manual human coding of a selected sample of the corpus is required. The assistants will do the manual coding, based on a codebook prepared by the instructor.
